Additional Recycling Notes

- Please dispose of waxed or food contaminated paper, frozen food boxes, drinking glasses, windowpanes, light bulbs, broken glass and paper towels as trash.
- All items must be empty and free of food debris.
- Remove plastic lids from plastic bottles.
- Do not place medical waste (needles, catheters or lancets) in the recycling container.
